

# Target Stand Plans

This stand will get you VERY close to World Archery specifications for height and angle when using a 48" or 52" target butt. They can be built in just a few hours, for around \$25 (with 1x4s), using treated 1 X 4s and standless steel hardware. They should last a very long time. 2 X 4s can also be used where the need for stability outweighs the need for portability. The bolts are 3/8" X 2-1/2". For 2 X 4s, use 3/8" X 3.5" or 4" carriage bolts. Use a 3/8" drill bit for snug fit, but a 13/32" bit probably wouldn't hurt. A 4.5-5" hex bolt works for the wheel axles (with 2x4s).
